Lufthansa Brings the World to Orlando International Airport



Orlando International Airport will be the 20th North American market to be served by Lufthansa. The international air carrier made the major announcement in a press conference in the boardroom of the Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA). The addition of Lufthansa's Frankfurt hub means 58 new destinations and convenient connections to 91 locations around Europe, Asia-Pacific, the Middle East and Africa for Central Florida travelers.



GOAA Board members, Orange County Mayor Richard Crotty and Orlando Mayor Buddy Dyer were on hand as the announcement was made along with Chris Schmidt,

Deputy Executive Director for the Greater Orlando Aviation Authority, Gary Sain, President and CEO of the Orlando Orange County Convention and Visitors Bureau along with Carmenza Gonzalez and Ray Gilley, President of the Metro Orlando Economic Development Commission.

Lufthansa will begin new service to Orlando International in October with five flights per week to Frankfurt, Germany. The airline will focus on premium travelers who can take advantage of the only First Class cabin from Orlando to Europe with amenities including a First Class terminal and lounges upon arrival in Germany.

Lufthansa is the industry leader in the number of international passengers it carries and is the 16th international carrier at Orlando International.

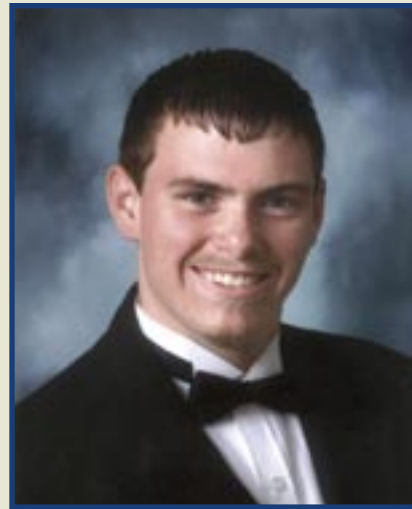
Liberty Weekend 2007

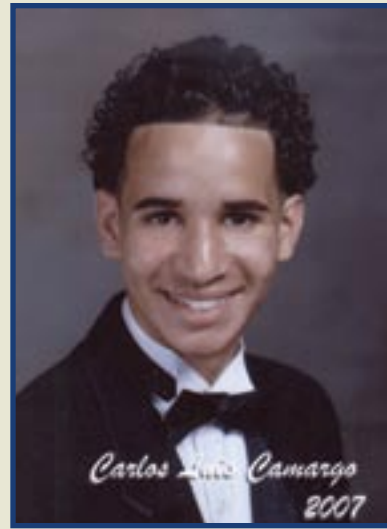


Hail to the Class of 2007

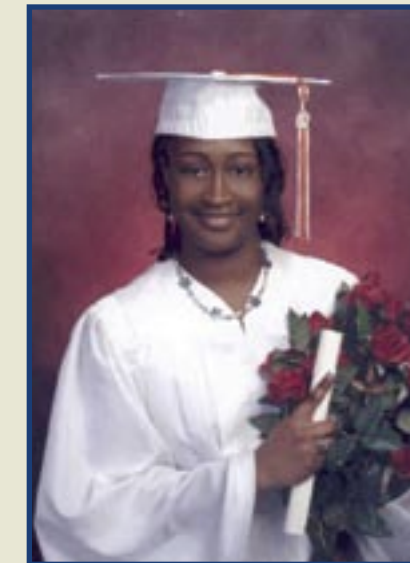
